Personnel news:

 Veronica Schack has retired from the OahuMPO as of the end of December 2022. We appreciate all Roni has done for the MPO and she will be missed! Training news:

- HRS Section 84-43 Mandatory Ethics Training goes into effect on January 1, 2023
 - Requires all state employees and public board members to take the mandatory ethics training developed by the Hawaii State Ethics Commission
 - Must be completed by January 1, 2024
 The training is available online: <u>Click Here</u>
- 2023 Transportation Project Management Training Program
 - Curriculum and schedule are being finalized
 - Begins on Friday, January 27, 2023
- FY2024-2025 OWP
 - The public and intergovernmental review period is anticipated to begin in mid-January 2023
- National Household Travel Survey (NHTS)
 - The household survey process wrapped up in early December after the goal of 2,500 survey responses was reached
- Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP)
 - We are currently finalizing Project Assignment Orders (PAO) and schedules for the consultant teams (PBR-Hawaii/Nelson Nygaard, and Urban Logic).
 - The ORTP Working Group is scheduled to meet again in early 2023.


