 FY2024-2025 Overall Work Program (OWP) is out for public and intergovernmental review from February 6 through March 3

- The public comment review for TIP Revision 11 **closed** on February 3.
 - We received 6 questions and 1 comment
- ORTP Working Group met on February 15
 - o Tasks and timeline for the ORTP were discussed.
 - The group will meet every other month through spring 2026
- The Oahu regional travel demand model is currently under development and will be available later this year.
- The second session of the Transportation Project Management Training Program was held on Friday, February 24


