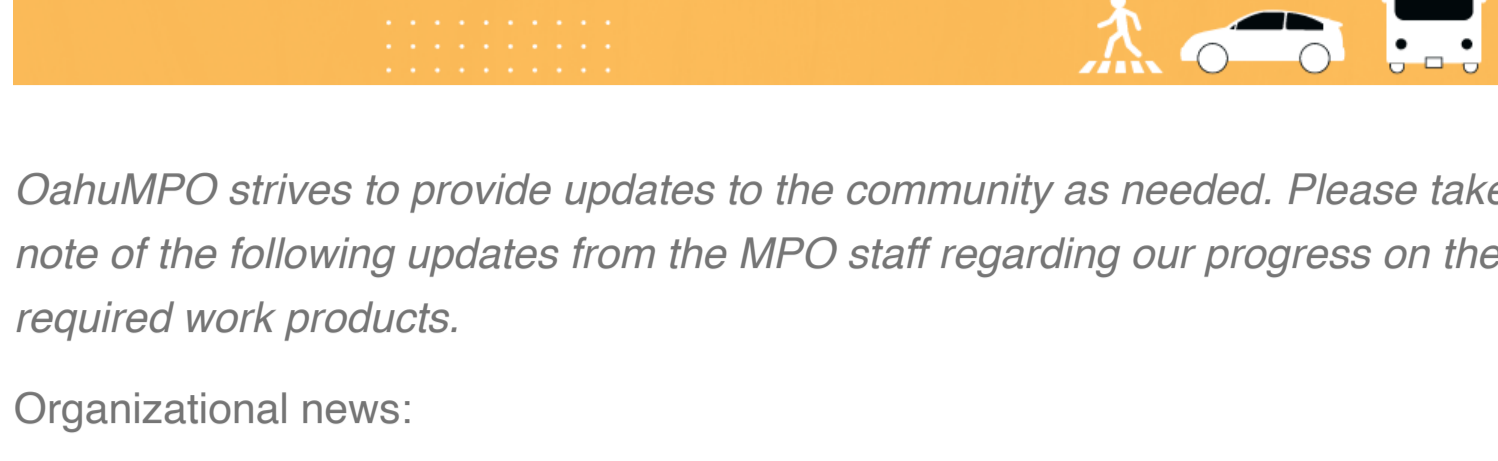


Aloha from the OahuMPO staff! Hello summertime! We hope you are all looking forward to the summer!
