INTRODUCTION

On an annual basis, no later than ninety calendar days following the end of the program year, the Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization (OahuMPO), Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT), City and County of Honolulu Department of Transportation Services (DTS), and the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) cooperatively develops a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which FHWA and FTA funds were obligated in the preceding program year.

The listing identifies all federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the preceding program year, the agencies responsible for carrying out the project or phase, and for each project, the amount of Federal funds requested in the TIP, the Federal funding that was obligated during the preceding year, and the Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years.
