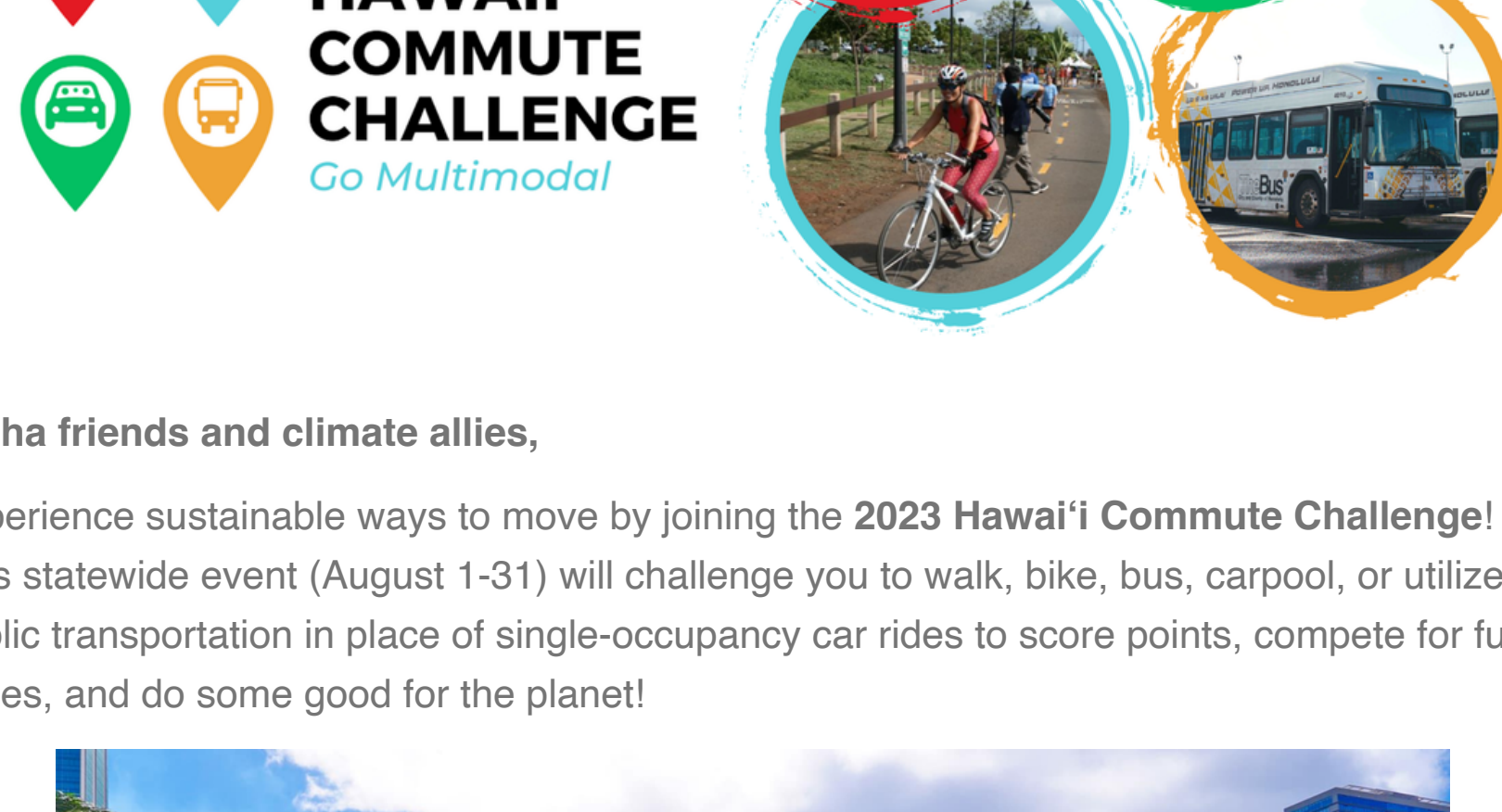

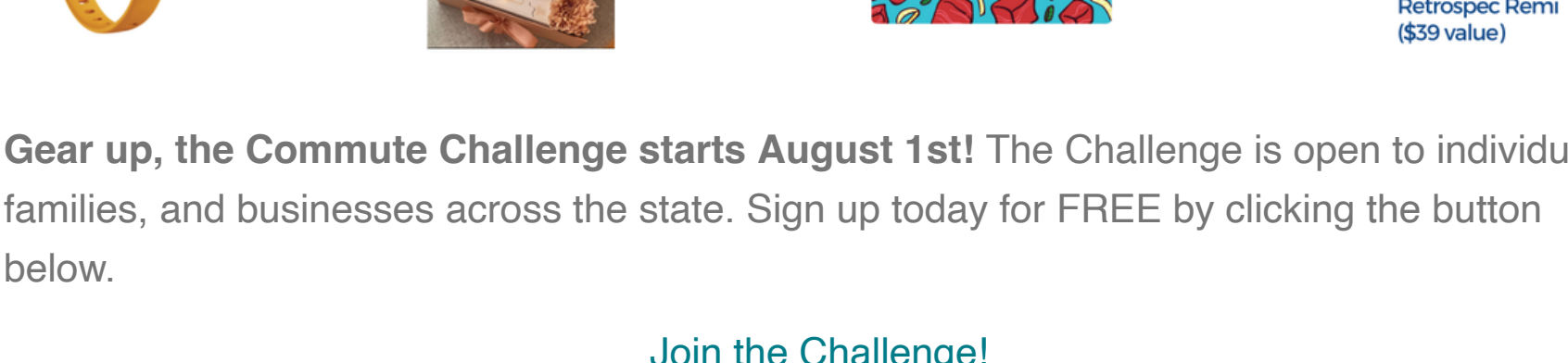
Aloha friends and climate allies,
