HDOT Latest news:

- Likelike Highway Safety Improvement Project
 - This project will install upgraded safety features to the newly paved Likelike Highway, from Nalanieha Street to the Wilson Tunnel
 - Lane closures are scheduled from February 26 through March 4, 2024
- Freeway Ramp Closures for Surface Treatment
 - Surface friction coating, to improve safety, will be installed at various on-ramps and off-ramps throughout the island as a safety measure.
 - Finalizing work on the ramp improvements is to be completed the week of Sunday, March 3 through Thursday, March 7
- Federal Aviation Administration FAA Awards \$30.6 Million For Hawaii Airport Improvements
 - \$30.6 million has been awarded to HDOT for improvements at the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport (HNL) and the Kahului Airport (OGG).
 - \$22 million to HNL
 - \$8.6 million to OGG
- Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) Launches Transportation Network Company Permit Application
 - Beginning March 1, 2024, transportation network companies (TNC) must have a valid permit from HDOT to operate in Hawaii.


