A. **Overall Work Program (OWP) FY2024-2025 Revision 1 Final Draft**

OahuMPO staff will present the final draft of Revision #1 to the OWP FY2024-2025. Revision #1 is an amendment that carries forward planning studies funded in prior OWP cycles for a net increase of \$2 million to the total work program budget. Revision #1 also programs \$121,746 in FTA 5305(d) funds from prior years and increases the budget for training and workforce development.

Requested Action: Approval of Revision #1 to the OWP FY2024-2025 as presented.

B. **Overall Work Program Presentation – Energy Conservation and Emissions Reduction Plan**

The City and County of Honolulu Office of Climate Change, Sustainability and Resiliency prepared an energy conservation and emissions reduction plan for City transportation systems with the support of OahuMPO planning funds. The plan establishes a City and island-wide baseline for transportation sector greenhouse gas emissions and forecasts trends to meet targets. The plan then identifies opportunities and constraints, design and development strategies, and policy and implementation measures to reduce transportation-related emissions. The planning study consultant will present the findings of the study.

Requested Action: Approve the report as evidence that the work was carried out, submit documentation of the work completed to the USDOT for approval, and incorporate study findings into the metropolitan transportation planning process.
