A. Regional Transit Safety Targets for 2024

The Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan (PTASP) regulation, 49 CFR Part 673, requires public transportation providers to establish Safety Performance Targets (SPTs). The City Department of Transportation Services (DTS) will present their adopted safety targets for 2024 for rail, bus, and paratransit services.

Requested Action: Recommend that the Policy Board support DTS' Transit Safety targets and direct OahuMPO staff to incorporate them into the metropolitan transportation planning process.

A. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) FFYs 2025-2028

The Transportation Improvement Program Federal Fiscal Years 2025-2028 (TIP FFYs 2025-2028) contains 80 existing projects that were carried over from the current TIP FFYs 2022-2025 and considerations for 12 new projects from the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP).

B. Overall Work Program (OWP) Presentation – Mobility Hub Study Phase I (State Facilities)

This study was funded in the OWP FY2021 with local match provided by the DLNR/State Climate Commission. The primary objective of the study was to identify potential sites for mobility hubs on state-owned parking lots, to improve transportation choices and help optimize state and county goals for clean transportation while maximizing the public benefit.

The consultants and OahuMPO's Project Manager will summarize the study outcomes.
