Executive Director's Report

Workforce Development and Training

OahuMPO Policy Board vice-chair Val Okimoto and Executive Director Mark Garrity attended the Hawaii Vision Zero Mobile Workshop in New York City and Northern Europe, from June 1-11. We were able to visit and experience locations where they have successfully reduced transportation related fatalities and serious injuries and meet with the leaders and project managers that made it possible. I will provide a detailed presentation on the workshop, including lessons learned and next steps, at the next CAC meeting.

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

The TAC met on June 14. They received a presentation from the City Department of Transportation Services (DTS) on Oahu's regional transit safety performance and associated objectives. They provided the proposed 2024 targets for each category for bus, paratransit, and rail. They voted to recommend the Policy Board support DTS's transit safety targets as presented.

They also received a presentation on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Federal Fiscal Years (FFY) 2025-2028 and voted to recommend the Policy Board approve. Finally, they also received a presentation on the Overall Work Program (OWP) funded Oahu Mobility Hub Study for State Facilities and voted to recommend the Policy Board approve.

Their next meeting is scheduled for July 12 at 9:00 AM.

The Policy Board met on June 24. They received a presentation on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Federal Fiscal Years (FFY) 2025-2028 and voted to approve.
