Executive Director's Report

Overall Work Program (OWP) Quarterly Financial Report

For your information, the most recent OahuMPO Quarterly Financial Report is attached to the end of this document.

Interagency Coordination and Grant Support

OahuMPO worked closely with the City Department of Transportation Services (DTS) staff to help them prepare an application for the USDOT Strengthening Mobility and Revolutionizing Transportation (SMART) Grant Program. If awarded, the grant would provide \$1.6 million to DTS to develop a Transit Signal Priority (TSP) system and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) to address safety, traffic congestion, system reliability, and equity on the Ala Moana Boulevard/Nimitz Highway corridor in Honolulu.

OahuMPO Open House

The OahuMPO held an open house on July 24, to allow members of the public to visit our offices and meet staff, to learn more about what the MPO does. A total of 18 people attended in person and participated in a lively and informative discussion about transportation planning on Oahu. We hope to have this type of event on an annual basis.



Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP) 2050 Survey

A public survey related to the ORTP 2050 was launched on August 1. It is an interactive and educational survey that prompts participants to prioritize the ORTP 2050 goals and objectives that were approved by the Policy Board. The OahuMPO is using an array of tools and strategies to cast a wide net for public input. We would appreciate your support by sharing the survey information, which is in a flyer attached to the end of this report. Information will also continue to be posted on our social media and website.

Policy Board

The Policy Board met on July 29. They received a request to approve the use of Federal Training, Education, and Workforce Development funds to allow Policy Board Chair Kila to travel and attend the Hawaii Conference of Planning Officials conference in Kamuela, Hawaii in September. This was approved by the Board.

They also received a presentation from Executive Director Mark Garrity regarding the Hawaii Vision Zero Mobile Workshop in New York City and Northern Europe that took place in June.

Their next meeting is scheduled for August 26 at 11:00 AM.

Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC meeting on August 7th was cancelled.

Their next meeting is scheduled for September 4 at 2:30 PM.
