## **Executive Director's Report**

### ***Grant Support for Mobility Hub Planning***

OahuMPO staff submitted a proposal for funding under the Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Capital Improvement Program from the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development's State TOD Council. If awarded the State funds, OahuMPO will carry out a planning study to evaluate the feasibility of establishing a multimodal mobility hub near the Kūwili Skyline Station in Iwilei. The goal of the study would be to assess locations near the Skyline station for a potential mobility hub to help improve transportation access to the Skyline station and improve overall connectivity and mobility of residents and visitors.

### ***Community Outreach for the ORTP 2050***

The OahuMPO has been running a survey for the month of August to gather feedback from the public about the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan and specifically about the goals and objectives. This interactive, educational survey provides information about each goal and the various modes of transportation available on Oahu. The survey is open until August 31, 2024, and I encourage you all to take the survey([link here](#)) and distribute it to your families, friends, and colleagues. Results of the survey results will be provided next month.

### ***Project Management Training Program***

The 2024 Transportation Project Management Training Program continues to meet monthly. The most recent session was on Friday, August 23, where the participants learned about building a culture of safety in the planning and design of transportation projects. They heard from representatives of the Federal Highway Administration, the State Department of Transportation, and the City and County of Honolulu. In the afternoon, we visited and toured the new Kalapawai Roundabout project in Kailua.

### ***Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC)***

The CAC did not meet in August.

Their next meeting is scheduled for September 4 at 2:30 PM.

### *Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)*

The TAC met on August 9.

They received a presentation on the Overall Work Program (OWP) funded Vision Zero Action Plan and voted to recommend the Policy Board approve the report. They also received a presentation regarding the proposed Regional Planning Priorities for the FY2026-2027 OWP. Finally, they received a summary of the Vision Zero Mobile Workshop in New York City and Northern Europe, attended by Policy Board Vice-Chair Val Okimoto and Executive Director Mark Garrity.
