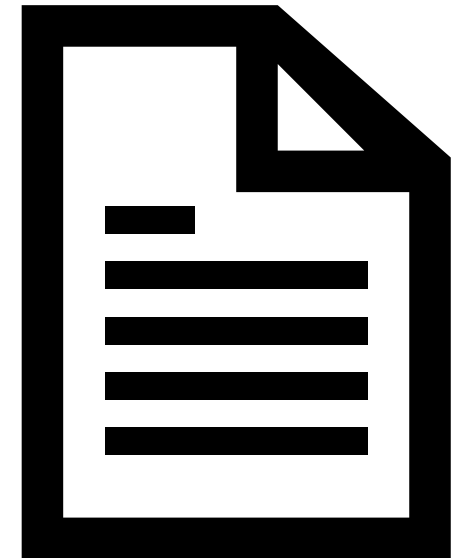

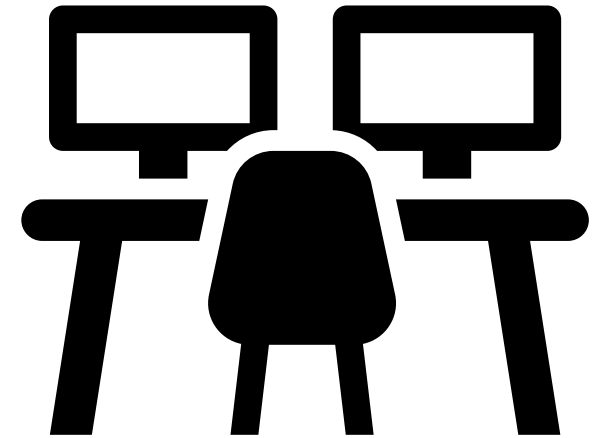
# Public Comment Period Summary (January 7-21, 2026)

- Public comment period closed January 21, 2026
- 63 public and agency comments received to date
- Broad support for the plan's vision, goals, and multimodal approach
- Strong emphasis on safety, transit, and active transportation investments
- Requests for clearer project details and alignment with existing plans (e.g., Navahine Settlement, TOD Plans)



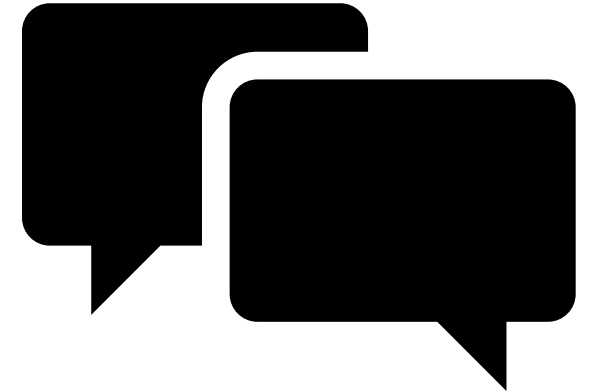
# Current Work Underway

- Responses and revisions will be documented in the final ORTP 2050



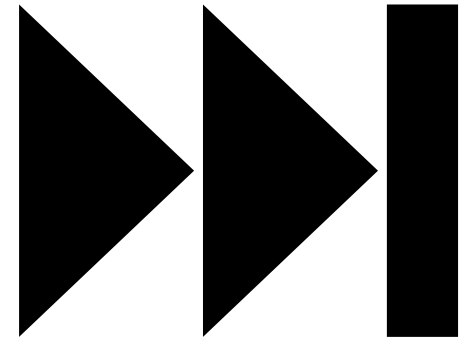
# How Feedback is Used

  - Present final ORTP 2050 for committee review and Policy Board adoption



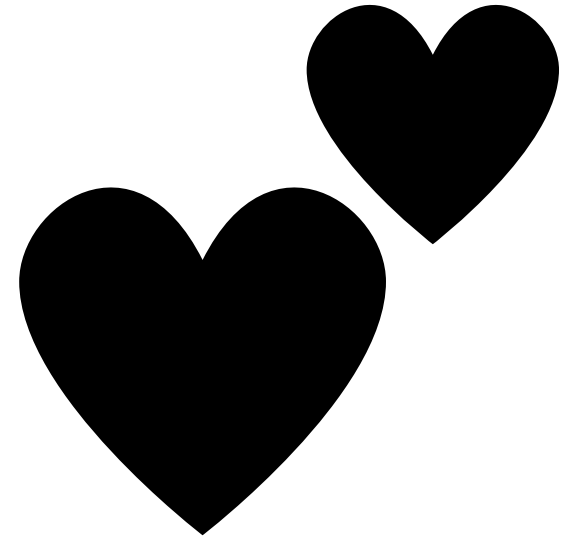
# From Plan to Action
