A. TIP FFYs 2025-28 Revision 9 Update

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a fiscally constrained, short-range program that identifies all federally funded and regionally significant surface transportation projects on the island of O‘ahu, as well as projects requiring action by federal transportation agencies.

The Oahu MPO is accepting comments to the Transportation Improvement Program Federal Fiscal Years 2025-2028 Revision 9 (TIP FFYs 2025-2028 Revision 9), which is an Amendment involving the removal of 1 existing project, and the addition of 9 new projects from the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP).
