Interim Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

- May 26, 2017, Policy Board Meeting, DTS presented and discuss the Traffic Signal Prioritization Methodology, Contra-Flow Update Study, Village Park-Kupuna Loop Sub-Area Corridor Study, and the Separate Left-Turn Phase Alternatives Study which they recommend that the Policy Board accept the recommendations as evidence the work was carried out, direct OahuMPO staff to use study recommendations in OahuMPO planning process.
- June 9, 2017, Technical Advisory Committee was presented the 2018 Overall Work Program (OWP), and received input about the substance of the work programs, and adjustments were recommended. Final OWP will be presented on July 12, 2017 TAC meeting.
