Interim Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

- FY2018 Overall Work Program was approved jointly by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration effective August 14, 2017.

Policy Board

Policy Board Meeting was held on July 28, 2017 in which the Board approved and forward the FY2018 Overall Work Program Final Draft to the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration.

The Policy Board received an update briefing of Transportation Improvement Project Revision (TIP) #17 to include each of the six project changes and the State Safety Oversight Program project which is included in the TIP Revision #17, and comments received during the review was noted, and changes were made to enhance the TIP atlas.

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

TAC met on September 8, 2017 and received a presentation from Oahu MPO staff concerning the new federal regulations regarding performance measures for transportation funding which will impact the preparation of the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP) and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

The Oahu MPO staff presented to the TAC the next four year (2019-2022) TIP document which must be approved in the summer 2018. The process is segmented to allow for a wide planning discussion with our stakeholders.
