1. Recreational Trails Program (State TIP Project #OS49)

This State project provides and maintains recreational trails for both motorized and non-motorized recreational use.

Which trails need maintenance?

2. Transit Safety and Security (City TIP Project #OC21)

This City project sets out to improve the safety of bus stops and transit centers.

Are there transit facilities that you feel could use safety improvements?

3. Traffic Improvements (City TIP Project #OC8)

Improvements are being made to Kailua, Mahoe and Waipahu Streets, and Manager's Drive at Hiapo Street, including accessible curb ramps, sidewalk improvements, bicycle lanes, and shared-use paths. While the City follows a process to identify streets for improvements, your comments are important.

Is there a specific street/intersection that could use improvements?

4. Traffic Signals (City TIP Project #OC10)

This City project sets out to install and upgrade traffic signals including signs and markings, and ADA improvements.

Is there a traffic signal that can be improved?

5. Bridge Maintenance (State TIP Projects (#OS76, #OS77, #OS78))

State bridges all over the island are scheduled for restoration and retrofit. If you know of a bridge in need of repair, let us know!
